Post show report

Cultivating a World of Trusted Security & Safety

The 26th edition of Secutech marked a new milestone as Asia's leading professional security and safety exhibition. With 396 companies from 9 countries including Taiwan, Japan, Australia, Korea, Spain, the United States, China, Germany, and Singapore, the show featured 505 booths across 15,120 sqm of exhibition space. The event welcomed 14,057 visitors from 44 countries, including 661 overseas professionals, solidifying its status as one of the most international and business-driven security trade fairs in the region.

Structured around 20 key topics across 5 major industry series, Secutech 2025 hosted 133 sessions attracting 1,954 attendees, offering comprehensive insights into smart security, fire safety, disaster prevention, access control, and AIoT solutions. Notably, 138 business matching sessions were arranged between 75 VIP overseas buyers and 70 exhibitors, fostering valuable cross-border partnerships. The presence of 8 international buyer groups from Japan Thailand, Vietnam, Indonesia, Myanmar, Singapore, Cambodia, the Philippines, and India further emphasized Secutech's role as a powerful platform for regional networking and business development across Asia and beyond.

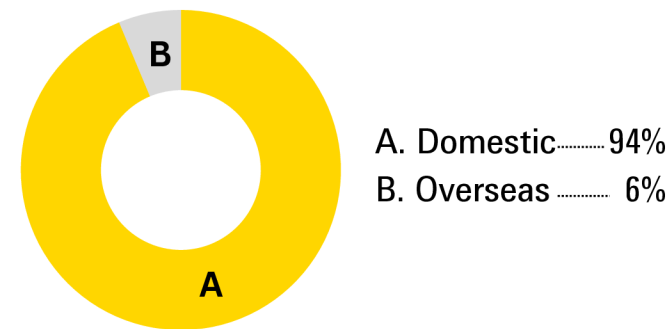

Held over three days, the fair attracted **14,057** industry professionals from **44** countries and regions, highlighting its global reach.

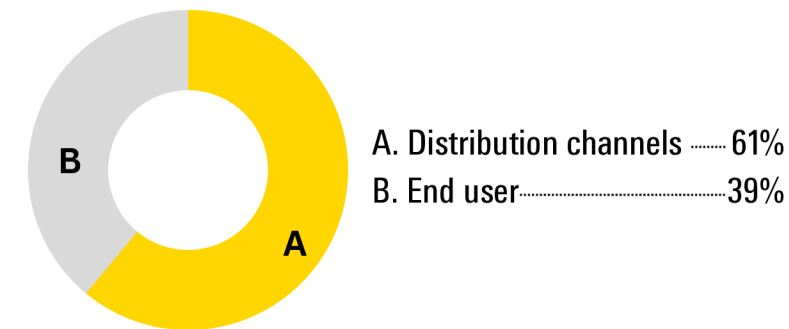

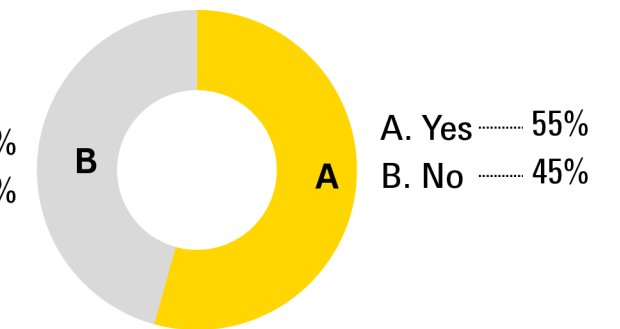

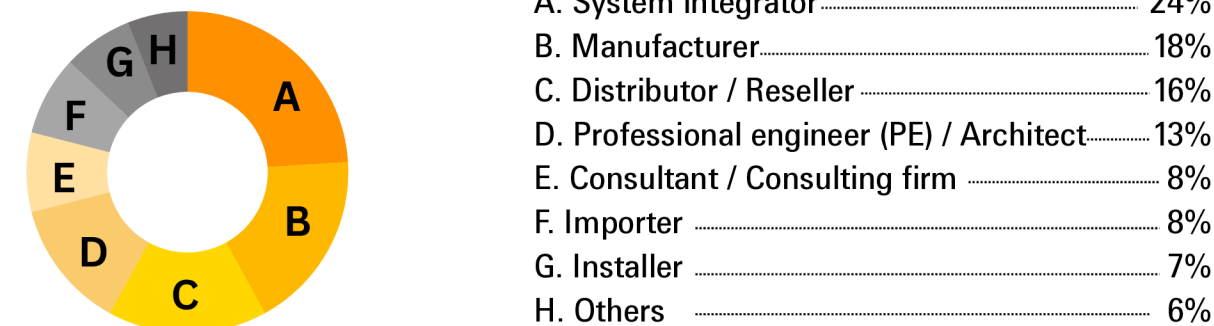
Visitors types



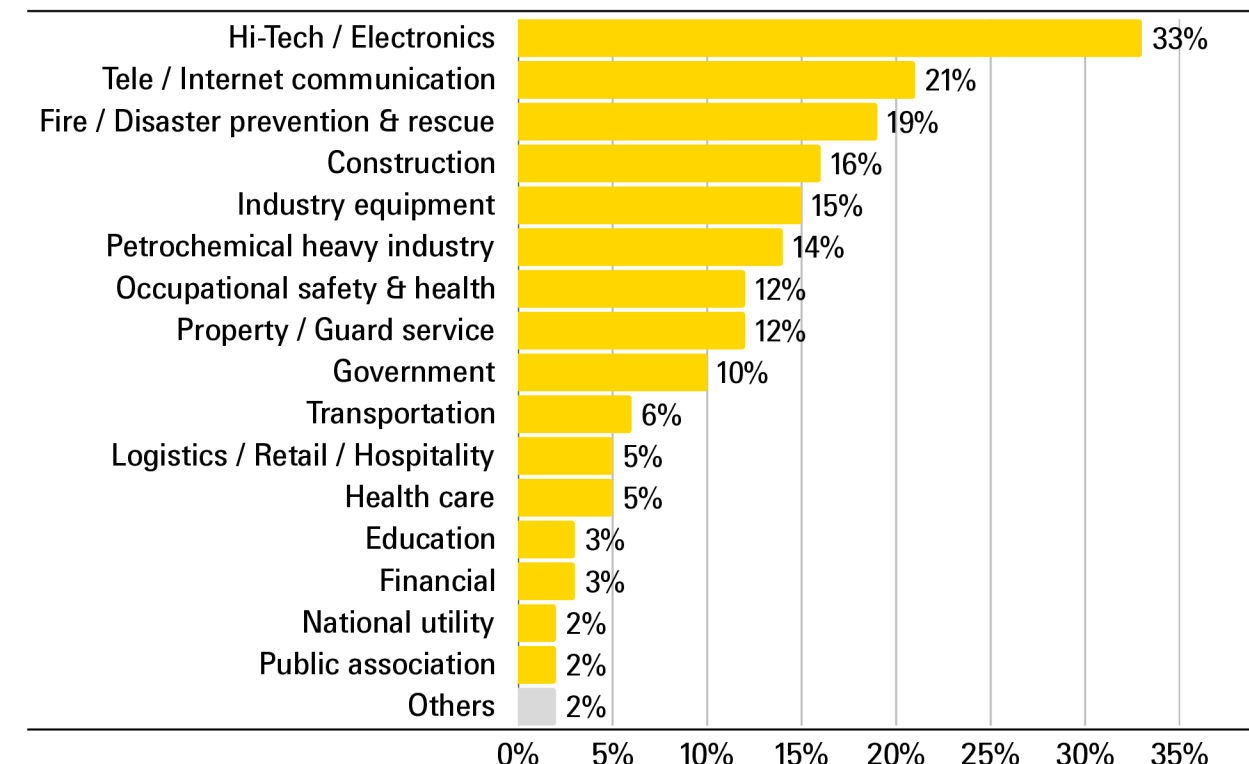
Authority in purchasing decisions



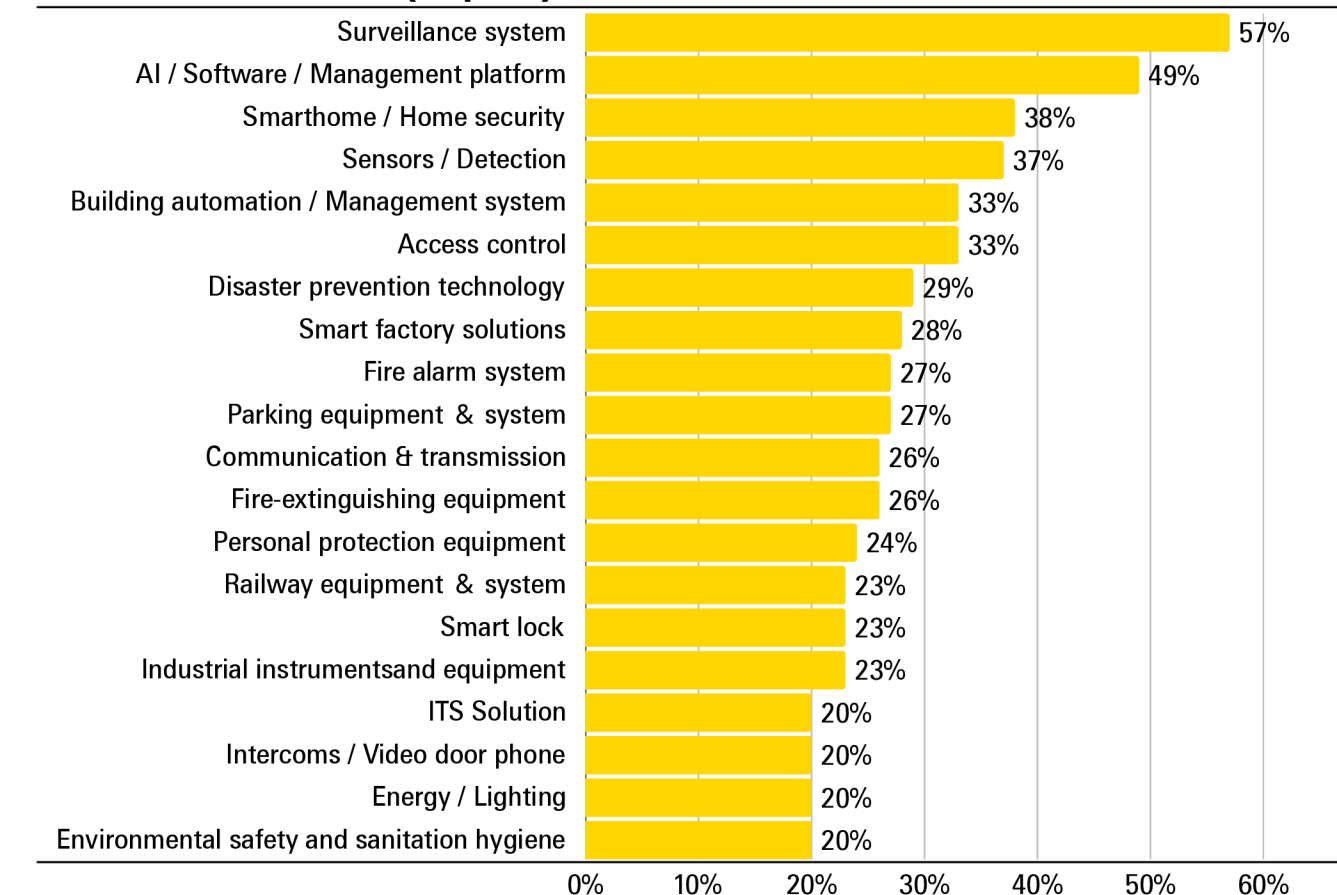
Business Nature



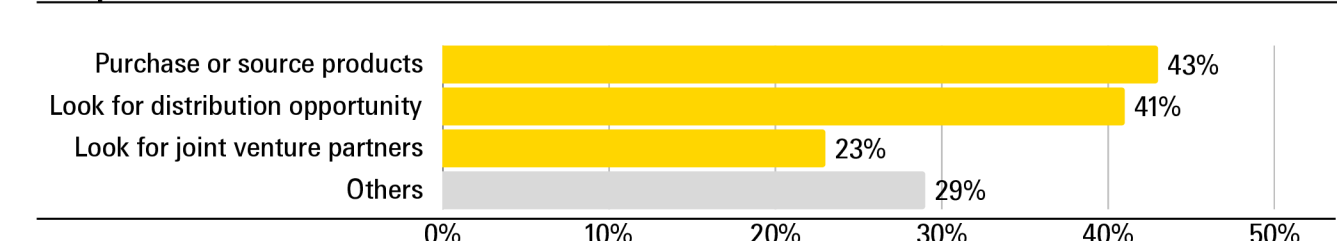
Area of Business

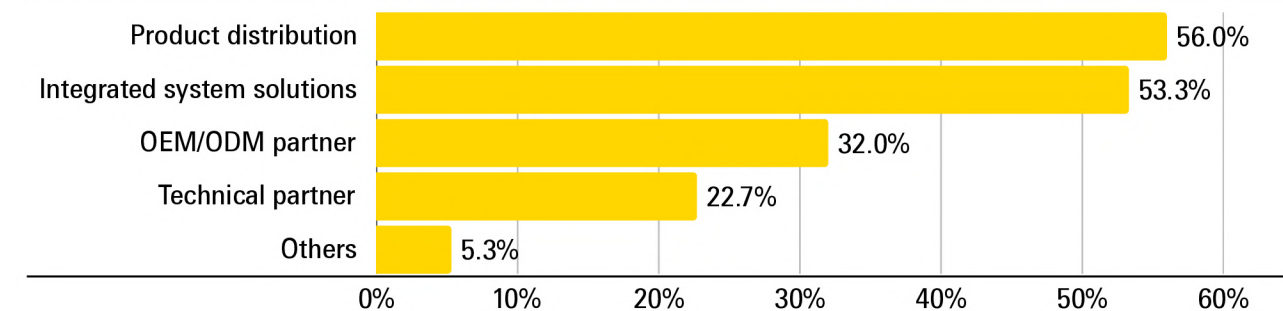
The high level of participation and targeted interactions reaffirmed Secutech’s role as a strategic platform for international procurement and partnership building within the security and safety industry.

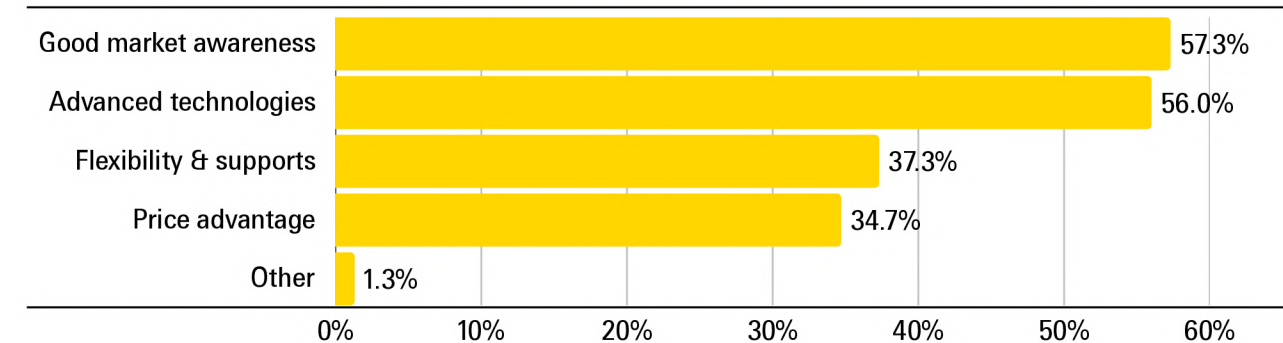

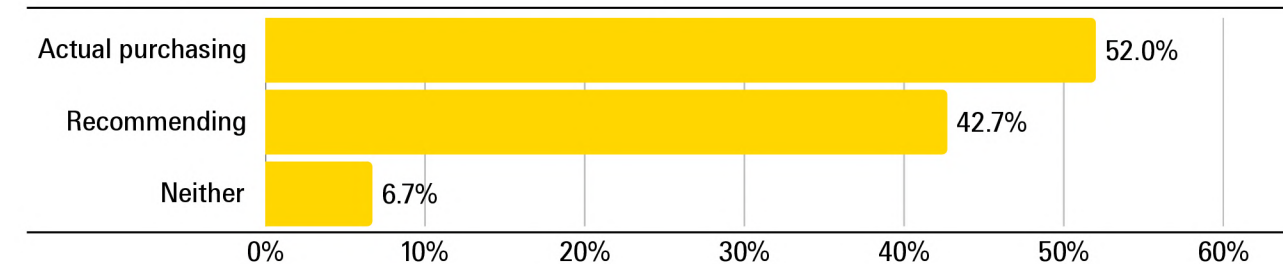
What types of business are you looking for at Secutech?

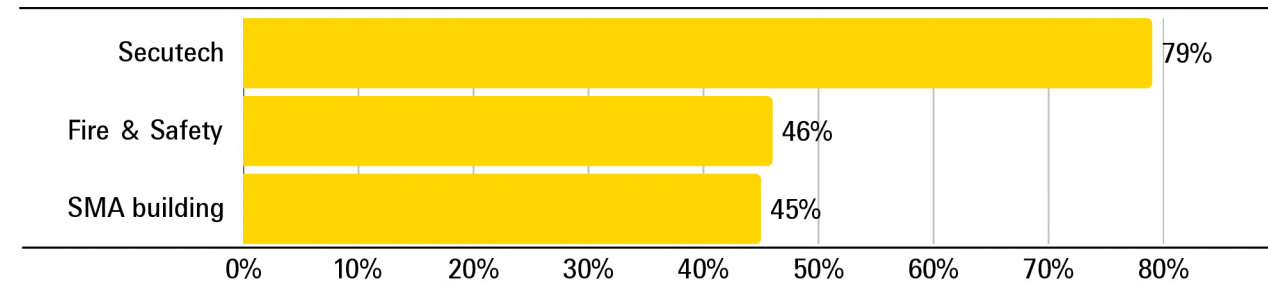

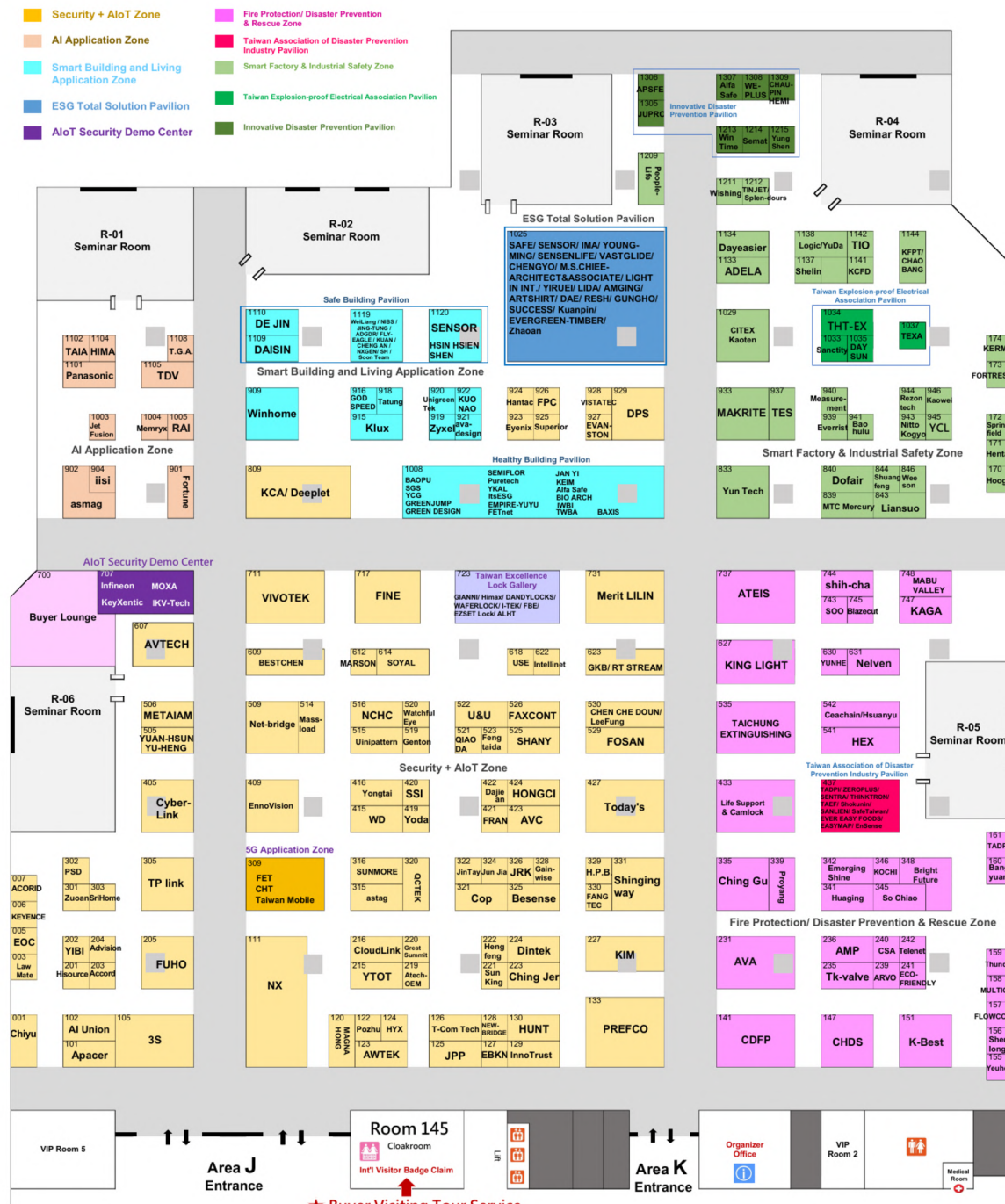
